

Regulations (Parking Space Administration Switzerland)

Where applicable, and so long as local regulations do not specify otherwise, the following usage rules apply to parking spaces:

- Regular traffic regulations apply, just as on public roads.
- Vehicle maintenance and repair work are prohibited.
- Unnecessary idling of engines is prohibited.
- Extended parking overnight, on weekends, during vacations, and on public holidays is possible if an external access medium is used. If access is by means of employee identification, extended parking is prohibited.
- Parking non-registered vehicles and/or vehicles without license plates is prohibited.
- Vehicles blocking access to, or in front of lanes, escape routes and emergency exits will be towed at the owner's or driver's expense.
- Leaving material in parking spaces and vehicle access ways is prohibited.
- Littering parking areas and vehicle access ways, e.g. emptying ashtrays etc. is prohibited.

The following rules also apply in CS parking garages:

- Low beams must be used, and there is a 20 km/h speed limit.
- Smoking is prohibited for safety reasons.
- To prevent marking and damage, vehicles may not be backed into parking spaces.
- Driving through barriers when directly behind another vehicle is not permitted.

If the rules are breached for the first time, a written warning is issued. In the case of a second violation, the parking space is terminated without notice. Credit Suisse also reserves the right to report culpable motor vehicle operators to the police.
